Bronx Culture Trolley (Wednesday)

On the first Wednesday of every month, ride along the South Bronx Cultural Corridor, a strip of the Grand Concourse that's home to various cultural institutions. There will be art exhibitions, film screenings and live performances this month, at the Bronx Museum of the Arts, Bronx Music Heritage Center Laboratory, BronxArtSpace, and Clock Cafe and Martini Bar. There will also be a concert by So Percussion at the Pregones Theater starting at 7:00 p.m.

Meeting time is at 5:00 p.m., Longwood Art Gallery, at Hostos Community College, 450 Grand Concourse, at 149th Street, Mott Haven, the Bronx, for a reception with light refreshments.
