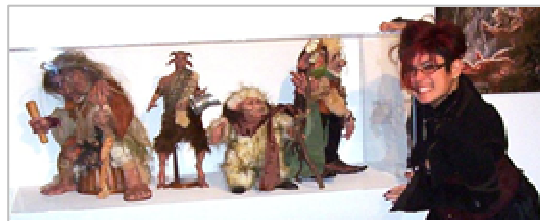

She graduated from the University of Puerto Rico achieving a Fine Arts BA Degree. She completed a Stop Motion Film at the School of Visual Arts, NY, achieving the Dusty Film Festival Award. She was nominated for a Student Academy Award 2001, for her stop-motion animation, *The Happy Prince*, by Oscar Wilde.
