

The **di.vi.sion piano trio** will feature “Quattro chiacchiere ed un aperitivo” by composer, David Keberle at the next “di.vi.sion@mediator” concert on Sunday, April 19, 2015 at 5 p.m. The composer will be in attendance to speak about his work. The trio will also be performing Beethoven’s Piano Trio in Eb Major, Op. 70 No. 2 and Haydn’s Piano Trio in Eb Major, Hob. XV:30. Suggested donation \$15; \$10 for students and senior citizens. The concert will be held at the Church of the Mediator, 260 West 231st Street, Bronx, NY 10463 (two blocks west of the 1 train).

David Keberle belongs to a generation of composer/performers whose musical background consists not only of a thorough classical conservatory training, but is augmented by extensive experience and understanding of today’s contemporary music and performance techniques. His “Soundings”, a series of pedagogical compositions utilizing extended techniques for soloists and student ensembles, have been premiered by illustrious soloists including clarinetist Richard Stoltzman, flutist Tara Helen O’Connor, violinist/violist Ida Kavafian, the German recorder collective QNG, and the Pittsburgh Symphony Horn Quartet. David Keberle is on faculty at the College of Staten Island, CUNY.
