This workshop is free and open to the public. All are welcome.

Be part of Laura’s imaginary world of color, fantastic creatures and fun characters. Using watercolor, block print, acrylics and ink, she recycles anything possible and transforms it into art, and she will show you how to do the same.



Visual artist, illustrator and educator **Laura Alvarez** was born in Valencia, Spain. She moved to the Bronx in 2009. After working as a graphic designer she slowly moved into the educational aspect of her career, teaching with such organizations the New York Botanical Garden, the Bronx Council of the Arts, YUCA Arts and SoBRO creating and teaching art. Her imaginary world is filled with color, fantastic creatures and fun characters. She uses different techniques like watercolor, blockprint, acrylics or ink, recycling anything possible and transforming it into art.
