A.J. Sidransky at BCA on Sept. 20

A J Sidransky, a 2013 National Jewish Book Award finalist and novelist, will speak briefly about his works and how he used certain techniques to improve them. Workshop participants will discuss their specific stories and what they would like to achieve. If a participant is working on a project they are welcome to bring a sample for the workshop activity, but no prior writing activity is necessary.

This one-time workshop will happen at the **Bronx Council on the Arts**, 2700 E Tremont Avenue, on Saturday, September 20th, at 4:30pm. It will run about two hours.

A J Sidransky is the author of *Forgiving Maximo Rothman*, a retelling of his family's history as refugees to the Dominican Republic in 1940 and *Stealing a Summer's Afternoon*, a semi-autobiographical work. He lives in Washington Heights and is a native of the Bronx
