BCA's LONGWOOD ART GALLERY @ HOSTOS (450 Grand Concourse at 149th Street / 718-518-6728)

- **Samaná: Images of the Dominican Republic** – Photographs by Marino Corniel, Elaine Eversley and Ryan Mann-Hamilton of the Samaná peninsula which was settled in the 1820s by freed slaves from the United States.
- **Quijumbo** – Afro-Dominican Percussion Jam with Ramón Abad y Palo Mayor in a program of secular and spiritual drumming of various traditions including Congo, Bambulá, Creole and others. 5:30pm, 6:45pm & 7:45pm performances.

BRONX MUSEUM OF THE ARTS (1040 Grand Concourse at 165th Street / 718-681-6000)

- **Intersections: The Grand Concourse at 100, part 2** – The second of this three-part exhibition presents specially commissioned projects by three contemporary artists considering present-day conditions along the Grand Concourse: Katie Holten (Ireland), Kabir Carter, and Jeff Chien-Hsing Liao (Taiwan).
- **A special Lobby installation by Acconci Studio** will significantly alter the Museum architecture.

THE TREE MUSEUM (Grand Concourse from 138th St to Mosholu Parkway / 212-729-1457)

- **The Tree Museum** – 100 trees run the length of the Grand Concourse and those with stories to tell can be identified by their sidewalk markers. Visitors can listen in on local stories and the intimate lives of trees offered by current and former area residents.

BRONX BLUE BEDROOM PROJECT (309 Alexander Avenue #3A / 347-776-7504)

- **GC2** – An exhibition about the Centennial of the Grand Concourse by filmmaker & new media artist Hector Canonge.

LDR STUDIO GALLERY (137 Alexander Avenue (#10, 4th floor) / 917-558-2389)

- **Visions of Horror** – Five artists involved in this Halloween exhibition display their feelings about life, death and this most theatrical and creative of our American holidays.

DIRECTIONS TO HOSTOS COMMUNITY COLLEGE

- The Longwood Art Gallery @ Hostos is located at Hostos Community College, 450 Grand Concourse and 149th Street, at a busy intersection just steps from the subway station and bus stop. By subway, take the #2, 4 or 5 IRT trains to 149th Street and the Grand Concourse. By bus, take the BX1 or BX19 to 149th Street and the Grand Concourse. Travel time from mid-town Manhattan is usually 20 minutes.
- By car from Manhattan, take the FDR drive north to the Willis Avenue Bridge to the Major Deegan Expressway (87N). Proceed north to Exit 3. Take the right fork in the exit ramp to the Grand Concourse and proceed north to East 149th Street.
- From Queens, take the Tri-borough Bridge to the Major Deegan Expressway. Continue north to Exit 3. Take the right fork in the exit ramp to the Grand Concourse and proceed north to East 149th Street.
