The **Bronx Council on the Arts** (BCA) and the Huntington Free Library (HFL) kick off their 2012-2013 family-friendly craft workshop series on Saturday, October 20 at Westchester Square's Huntington Free Library with a fun and spooky afternoon of Halloween Arts & Crafts with Fran Marino.

Mad Scientists of all ages are invited to create their own stuffed ghosts, ghouls, or creatures (fairies, kitties, pumpkins, candy corn, etc.). Spend the day drawing, gluing, coloring, cutting, and stuffing! The workshop runs from 12:30-3:00pm. The Huntington Free Library is located at 9 Westchester Square (next to the Apple Savings Bank). Admission to this workshop is free, open to the public. All are welcome.

Halloween Arts & Crafts with Fran Marino is part of the free series of Third Saturday Family Craft Workshops presented by BCA and HFL through April 20, 2013 at the Huntington Free Library.

Fran Marino is a Bronx-raised artist and Fashion Institute of Technology graduate with a background in the Textile Design industry and as an Art teacher in the Catholic and Public school systems. Marino has worked with a number of Bronx community organizations, coordinating outdoor art and music exhibitions, including Bronx Week events at the Bronx County Court House. She has exhibited in group exhibitions in New York and in Connecticut where she received an "Honorable Mention" for one of her more current pencil drawings. Locally, Marino has exhibited her work at City Island's Focal Point Gallery, had a one-woman exhibition at Westchester Square's Huntington Free Library, and has been an active member of the Bronx Council on the Arts of BCA's Artisans Collective.
