(Bronx, NY – November 30, 2015) The Bronx Council on the Arts (BCA) and the Huntington Free Library (HFL) continue their 2015-2016 family-friendly craft workshop series on Saturday, December 19, 12:30-3:00pm at Westchester Square's Huntington Free Library with a fun-filled ***Green T-Shirts Workshop with Diane Davis.***

Bring a used T-shirt and your imagination! You will be supplied with bottle caps, scissors, ribbons, broken jewelry parts, swatches, markers, needle and thread and a slew of ideas and instructions. Wear your T-shirt or hang it on the wall as a wonderful piece of artwork. You can even bring your own adornments for your shirt.

Admission to this workshop is free and open to the public. All are welcome.

Green T-Shirts with Diane Davis is part of the free series of Third Saturday Family Craft Workshops presented by BCA and HFL through May 21, 2016 at the Huntington Free Library.



Diane Davis is a fine artist who mixes color palettes to provide emotional density through textures and form. Her ongoing visual exploration of the urban environment is acknowledged for its range and scope. Two paintings, *Sunrise Dancers* and *Log Cabin*, are in the permanent collections in NYC's Schomburg Center for Research and Black Culture. Among the many museum and gallery exhibitions to her credit are the Hampton Museum, Hampton, VA; the MoCada Museum, Brooklyn, NY; The Elizabeth Foundation for the Arts, NYC; The Longwood Art Gallery, Bronx, NY; and The National Black Fine Arts Show, NYC. Her work has received considerable attention in the documentary "NINE BY FIVE: Nine artists, Five boroughs, One city," local-news television broadcasts and in print media. She continues to explore opportunities to share art.

The family craft workshop series continues on January 16, 2016 as BCA presents ***Journal Making with Lis Ortiz.*** New year, new beginnings...So come and create your own handmade personal journal to capture your new year's thoughts, hopes and dreams. Journals will be made of recycled items, so please feel free to bring images, fabric and/or items to make yours extra special!
