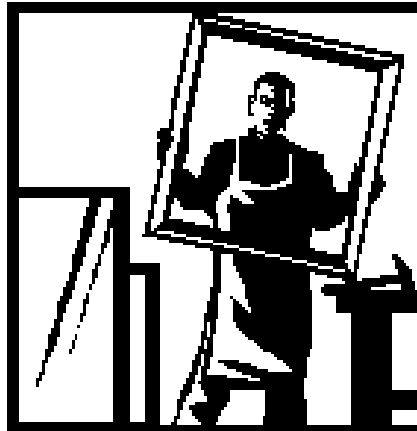


Art Handler Training Program

- Have experience with basic hand/power tools ex: hammers, saws, pliers, wrenches, etc. and be familiar with construction materials.
