Bronx Council on the Arts seeks Bronx Artists 2014 BRIO Award Applications available online Friday, November 1, 2013

(Bronx — October 18, 2013) Bronx Council on the Arts (BCA) presents the 2014 **B**ronx **R**ecognizes **I**ts **O**wn (BRIO) awards application and guidelines, starting Friday, November 1, 2013 at **www.bronxarts.org**. The BRIO applications will only be available online.

This year's online application submission deadline is Friday, January 31, 2014, 11:59 pm.

BCA's BRIO Fellowship program celebrates 25 years in 2014 of supporting individual artists in the creation of work in literary, media, performing, and visual arts. Bronx artists may apply in one of the following categories: Acting, Choreography, Crafts, Dance, Digital Arts, Fiction, Film Animation, Illustrated Text, Illustration/Artist Book, Installation Art, Instrumental and Vocal Music Performance, Mixed Media, Music Composition, Narrative/Documentary/Experimental Film/Video, Non-Fiction, Painting, Performance Art, Performance Poetry, Photography, Playwriting, Poetry, Printmaking/Drawing, Screenwriting, Sculpture, Spoken Word, and Storytelling.

A total of 25 awards of \$3,000 each are available to Bronx artists. Eligible applicants must be 18 years or older, live in the Bronx, and may NOT be enrolled as a full-time graduate or undergraduate student. Individuals who work for BCA or who are recipients of any of the Council's awards in 2013-14 including BRIO, Arts Fund, or Community Arts Grant, are also ineligible.

- Wednesday, January 22, 2014, 5:00-8:00pm, at Hostos Community College, room C-391, 450 Grand Concourse at 149th Street, Bronx NY 10451.

Individual Consultations by appointment only can be arranged with the BRIO Administrator. For Literary Applicants, 1-on-1 half-hour consultations can be arranged with the Bronx Writers Center Director to help prepare your manuscript for BRIO. The selection of awards are based solely on artistic excellence and decided by a panel of arts professionals of various disciplines. All materials involved in the selection process are reviewed anonymously. All applicants are notified of panel decisions by e-mail approximately four months after the deadline date. Winners are invited to an awards ceremony in June 2014 to receive the first payment of \$2,500. The remaining balance of \$500 is to be paid to the artist upon completion of a community service activity which is required of all awardees.

Funding for BRIO is provided by the NYC Department of Cultural Affairs-Greater New York Arts Development Fund. Additional funding is provided by the NYS Council on the Arts. Lambent Foundation Fund of Tides Foundation, and BCA's membership program.
