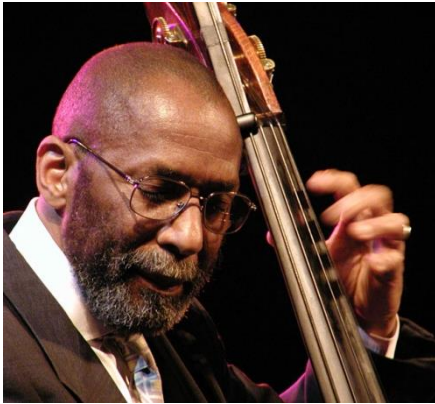

Davis is laid to rest at 'Jazz Corner', next to Duke Ellington and many other notable jazz musicians.

Ron Carter played with Miles Davis' 'Second Great Quintet' in the 1960s and is an actively touring musician today, as well as being the most recorded jazz bassist in history. Ron Carter will perform with his trio in an **outdoor concert** at the Jazz Corner, paying tribute to his old mentor.
