(Bronx, NY – March 23, 2016) The Bronx Council on the Arts is proud to present two performances of a new dramatic musical composed by BRIO 2015 Award winner Penny Prince. These performances will occur on Saturday, May 14, 2016, starting at 11:00 am and again at 2:30 pm at the Bronx Library Center. Dr. Penny Prince is a composer, lyricist, pianist, and educator. She is a professor of music at Lehman College, City University of New York, where her interests include music education, and collaborative musical theatre. Dr. Prince holds degrees in piano and music education from Manhattan School of Music and N.Y.U. She has written over 200 musicals in which she collaborates on scripts with students ages 6-100, for which she has won 14 ASCAP merit awards. She is an active presenter and panelist in all things musical, and serves the community with her writing and activism.
