Rhythm Connects is an inter-generational family program for adults and their children between the ages of 7-17 on the Autistic Spectrum. *Rhythm Connects* offers the unique opportunity to have a meaningful bonding experience and to explore new ways of personal expression and communication through drumming.

In an inviting, accepting, comfortable and FUN environment, this drum circle program creates an opportunity for you to connect with your child (and yourself) at a deeper level, and also allows you to connect with a group of other like-minded people.

Drumming in a group provides an authentic experience of unity, to feel what it is like to be in a state of *preverbal* connectedness. Group drumming can alleviate isolation, and alienation, providing a sense of connectedness with others and enable interpersonal support.
