Paintings: Oil, watercolor, pastel, acrylic, mixed media

Photography: Conventional and digital enhanced.

Sculpture: Metal, wood, textiles, mosaic

Youth: High School Students

TERMS and CONDITIONS

The theme is ANIMALS – cats, dogs, birds and all non-human species. This call is open to all visual artists working in 2-D and 3-D mediums including, but not limited to painting, mixed media, drawing, printmaking, fiber, textiles, photography and wall-mounted or framed sculptural relief.

Framed Dimensions for each entry must not exceed 36 inches x 48 inches. Artwork must be matted (as appropriate), framed and wired for installation purposes. Individual works may have a maximum weight of 75 pounds. Submitted 3D works or sculptures over 50 lbs. must be set up by the artist and be stable and safe for viewing. Due to space limitations, submissions for sculpture must not exceed overall dimensions of 24 inches H x 24 inches W x 7 inches D.

Please indicate your name, address, telephone number, title of work and sale price on all objects.

Artwork submitted can be considered for sale. United Hebrew will retain a commission of 30% on all work sold. All selected works must be made available for the duration of the exhibition

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Entries must be submitted as JPG Files sized at 10inches max height or width and 72dpi. Max 5 images.

DELIVERY and RETURN of ARTWORK FOR EXHIBITION:

Artists will be responsible for delivery and return of artwork. You may drop off/pick up or ship by mail. Artists are responsible for delivery and return shipping costs, transportation and in route insurance costs. United Hebrew will use all due care in the handling of artwork but artists must elect to insure his/her own work for the duration of the exhibition, if desired. Submitted works must have a maximum retail gallery price of no more than \$2,000. Work should be sent in a substantial, reusable box or packing crate. Work not packed in this manner will be returned to sender and not exhibited. **NO STROFOAM PEANUTS SHOULD BE USED FOR PACKING MATERIAL.** All selected work must arrive by September 8 and be ready to be hung or installed (with all applicable hanging/wire mechanisms and installation instructions included)
